

Parking---CWS Games

- ☆ Take Interstate 80 EAST
- ☆ Take 13th Street NORTH
- ☆ Go to Bancroft Street
- ☆ Go RIGHT on Bancroft
- ☆ Go to 7th Street
- ☆ Go RIGHT on 7th Street
- ☆ Enter Bancroft School parking lot
- ☆ Wait for CWS Shuttle to take you to the stadium
- ☆ Allow 30 minutes between parking and stadium arrival



College World Series Concession Stand Worker Instructions

**Reminder: All teenage workers must be 16 years old or older.
Valid ID is necessary.**

There are no beer sales at the College World Series.

PARKING & SHUTTLE SERVICE:

Designated parking for concession stand workers is at Bancroft. Take the NORTH 13th Street exit (going away from the stadium) Drive to Bancroft Street, turn right. The school is at

7th & Bancroft. You can park anywhere in the lot. Shuttle buses will take you to the stadium and back to your car. Shuttles run from the school from 8 am to approximately 12 pm. Do not leave valuable personal items in your car. Lock everything in your trunk and/or take valuables with you. Better yet, leave valuables at home! Be sure to arrive at Bancroft School ½ hour before you are scheduled to work to allow for shuttle time.

GATE ENTRANCE:

Enter the stadium at the Plaza Entrance (left field side). You must check in by giving them your name and our group name (Millard West Band Boosters). You will be given an armband to wear. Please note each day the armband color will be different. Anyone in the stadium without an armband or a ticket will be escorted out.

OUR BOOTH:

Our assigned booth is #13 (the only air conditioned booth in the stadium, by the way!) As you enter the stadium, turn right. Go past Famous Dave's stand and the Hall of Fame Room. Booth #13 is just past the Hall of Fame Room.

DRESS CODE:

- Dress code is Khaki or Tan pants or shorts (no short shorts).
- Comfortable, non-slip footwear. Shoes must be closed toe and closed heel.
- Wear a lightweight T-shirt or tank top, as you will be given a Center Plate Mesh Shirt & Visor that must be worn by all concession staff. You get your shirt and visor when you check in at the Volunteer Check in Office.
- If booth activity slows down and you want to leave the booth and check out the game or go to the bathroom, you must take off your Center Plate Shirt & Visor.

PRODUCT SPOILAGE:

Anything spoiled, dropped or wasted must be written down on the spoilage sheet. For example, if you drop a large soda cup on the floor, mark it down as one spoiled large pop on the spoilage sheet so ending inventory will be counted correctly. Money will be taken from our profits if these things are not written down. THERE WILL BE A SPECIAL BOX FOR SPOILAGE ITEMS. EVERYTHING IN THIS BOX WILL NEED TO BE INVENTORIED AT END OF GAME.

EATING:

- Everyone working is allowed to have one or two free food items while working at the booth but all items eaten by workers must be recorded on the Eaten Inventory Sheet provided with the inventory clipboard.
- You may bring your own water bottle.
- We are given small courtesy cups for pop. DO not use any of the concession stand cups for drinks unless you write it down as a staff eaten item.
